Plantation Drive





On August 30th, 2024, **AGRO RANGERS** had the privilege of hosting a meaningful agroforestry sapling plantation drive in collaboration with 60 dedicated members of the **Schaeffler India Limited** team at Pimpri Budruk, Rajgurunagar. This joint initiative saw the planting of over 360 saplings, including Mango, Guava, Sapota, Mosambi, and Papaya – each symbolizing a collective commitment to a sustainable future.

Training Program





On 9th July, **AGRO RANGERS** had the privilege of conducting a transformative one-day training program on Regenerative Organic Farming for the farmers of **Kendraimata Agro Producer Company Ltd.** in Kendur, Pune district. The training received an overwhelming response, with 60 farmers, including 36 women farmers, actively participating.

The program aimed to introduce the principles of regenerative organic farming and its benefits for improving soil health, enhancing productivity, and fostering a sustainable farming future. Throughout the session, farmers engaged enthusiastically, expressing keen interest in transitioning to regenerative practices and working closely with **AGRO RANGERS** to boost their livelihoods.

A highlight of the day was the felicitation of the **AGRO RANGERS** team and Siddhesh Sakore, who was honored by the farmers for his recognition as a "**Land Hero**" by the **UN Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD)**. This recognition underlines our ongoing efforts to combat soil degradation and promote sustainable agricultural solutions.



Workshops



On 16th July 2024, **AGRO RANGERS** organized a follow-up training session with a field visit for the dedicated farmers of **Kendraimata Agro Producer Company Ltd**. at Vadgaon Patole, Pune district, Maharashtra. This hands-on training session was a continuation of our commitment to promoting regenerative organic farming and agroforestry practices.

A total of 25 farmers, including 10 enthusiastic women and 15 men, actively participated in the session. The day provided an immersive learning experience as farmers explored different organic farming models and engaged in practical demonstrations at an agroforestry farm.

This field visit not only imparted valuable insights into sustainable agriculture but also strengthened the farmers' confidence in adopting these regenerative practices. Through such initiatives, **AGRO RANGERS** remains dedicated to improving the livelihoods of smallholder farmers while fostering environmental stewardship.





AGRO RANGERS conducted a workshop for farmers from Bhend Village in Solapur District on 27
July 2024. A total of 31 farmers, including 18 women and 13 men attended the workshop, where they

decided to collaborate for the betterment of these farmers, exploring possible project
implementations to support their livelihoods.
